



Reservation, Cancellation and Refund Policy

Type of Trip	Reservation Policy	Balance Due / Cancellation Policy
Private Trips (hiking, biking, backpacking, camping, skiing, snowshoeing)	20% deposit due at booking	Deposit is non-refundable. Remainder of payment is due upon completion of the trip.
Open Registration Group Trips (Bike-Cations, Avalanche Courses, Bike Clinics)	100% of trip/course fee due at booking	Cancellations made more than 30 days before the start of the course receive a 100% refund. No refunds given within 30 days of the course start. (Our pricing depends upon meeting a minimum number of participants. In the event of low registration we prefer to give you the option to pay a surcharge that will cover the costs of a smaller group.)
Hut Trips	100% of hut fees and 20% of guiding fees due at booking.	Deposit and hut fees are non-refundable. Remainder of payment is due upon completion of the trip.
